

Title: What Happened at Pentecost?

Text: Acts 2:1-21

Take your Bibles and turn with me to the book of Acts. The book of Acts chapter 2...

Today is Pentecost Sunday. Today is the day that the church celebrates the COMING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. The disciples were told by Jesus to wait in the upper room "for what the Father had promised." What was it that the Father promised. In Acts chapter 1 verse 5 we read "Jesus said, John baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit"

So, following the Ascension of Christ, the disciples were in the upper room waiting for promise of the Father. They were praying. They had chosen Matthias to take the place of Judas. They had been in the upper room for 10 days. All the followers of Christ were there. Around 120 of them. And they were waiting to receive this power from on high.

Now, I would like to ask you the question: WHAT HAPPENED ON THIS DAY? what happened that makes this day so special in the life of the church?

Acts chapter 2 beginning with Vs 1.....(Read Acts 2:1-21)

#### PRAYER

Our Father, we recognize that we have no right to human opinion when we come to Your Word. That the intent of this hour must be to examine the Word of God and what it says. And Father we remember that your Word is sharper than any two edged sword. And will pierce even that point where soul and spirit are divided in your knowledge. And the Word of God is a discernor of the thoughts and intentions of our hearts.

Father, I pray for everyone who has come today. That the message of God maybe clear in their minds. That there would be no question as to what happened on this day so long ago.

We thank you, Father, for the Spirit of truth who has promised to guide us into all the truth and to bring to our remembrance whatsoever things you have said unto us.

So, I pray that your Holy Spirit might control the thoughts and words of this hour. And we ask this in Jesus name.....Amen.

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Now, WHAT HAPPENED ON THE DAY OF PENTECOST? In my study of this chapter and especially in the first 21 verses, I see four things that occurred on the day of Pentecost. And I would like to share these 4 things that happened with you.

(1 )Number one, there are miracles of God being performed. There are miracles of God being performed on the day of Pentecost. Basically, there are three miracles.

In Vs 2, there is the miracle of sound.

In Vs 3, there is the miracle of sight.

And in Vs 4, there is the miracle of speaking.

So, there are three miracles that are performed on the day of Pentecost.

Now, let's look carefully at those three miracles.

(1 )First, the miracle of Sound. What happened concerning the miracle of Sound?

(1 )I notice, first of all, that it was a very sudden event. The Bible says, Vs 2, "that suddenly there came a sound." The word "suddenly" is the Greek word for "unexpected." In other words, they were taken by surprise.

Nw, Jesus did not indicate tha the Holy Spirit would come on the day of Pentecost. He simply said to stay in Jerusalem untill he does come. So, it was unexpected. The disciples did not plan this.

A lot of people have the idea that they were all together and planing for this event. No..that is not what they did. They were all together..all 120 of them..They were waiting in the upper room for the spirit to come. And when He came, it took them by surprise.WHAT TOOK THEM BY SURPRISE?....THE SOUND. ....Unexpectely there came a sound

(2 )Secondly, notice the source of the sound.

According to Vs 2, it came from heaven. Not from the atmosphere of the earth. But, literally from "THE HEAVEN." The definite article "THE" is there.

Why do I point that out? Because "THE HEAVEN" is referring to the place where God dwells. This sound is coming from God. Just like it did in Exdous chapter 19 in the giving of the Law at Mt. Sinai. There was a great sound and the appearance --fire. Those two signs indicate God's presence.

And you have the same two signs here at Pentecost. And the sound came from heaven.

(3 )Third, you will notice that this miracle of SOUND is similar to something. It says it is like a violent, rushing wind.

By the way, the word "SOUND" comes from a root word meaning "like thesea roaring"...

You are standing down at the ocean and listening <sup>to</sup> to the waves <sup>crashing</sup> against the shore. That noise of the waves, the roar of the waves, is the sound they were hearing. And it was like a wind bearing violence. Often referred to as hurricanes or cyclones.

So, don't get the idea that this is just a wind blowing through the window. <sup>It was an</sup> enormous sound.

(1) <sup>Family, Mother</sup> And ~~I would like you to see~~ the scope of this sound. At the end of Vs 2 it says: "it filled the whole house where they were sitting." The entire house was filled with this sound. We are told in the book of Exodus that <sup>God's</sup> sound was like a trumpet that wax loud and louder and louder. An intense dramatic sound... We are told that the voice of God is like the sound of many waters. And I don't think it is an assumption on my part to say that the miracle of sound was the HEARING OF THE VOICE OF GOD. They didn't hear any "Words" evidently from the text. They couldn't discern anything. But a tremendous sound was heard.

And as you trace these words which are describing this Sound throughout the Bible you come to one conclusion: THAT IT WAS GOD WHO THUNDERED OUT HIS VOICE. It was the <sup>Voice</sup> sound of God. It came right out off "the heavens." And it filled the whole house where they were sitting. And it was like a hurricane or a cyclone in intensity. So, it is no wonder the Bible says it came "suddenly" or "unexpectedly." <sup>O.K. That was the first miracle</sup>

(2) Now, what was the second miracle that occurred? It was the miracle of "SIGHT"... Vs 3 says "there appeared to them".....

The word "appear" is simple the word "TO SEE." They saw something. WHAT DID THEY SEE?....."tongues as of fire distributing themselves" Now, it doesn't say "IT WAS FIRE". It says "tongues as or like fire. It looked like fire.

And they were distributing themselves, on or over, each one of them. Can you imagine what this was like? 120 people ...men and women and some children sitting around in a room. And an intense sound, like a cyclone and then over each person is a tongue like fire sitting there and they were all seeing it.....

A miracle of sight.....And I remaind you that it was Jesus who  
who predicted that this event was the baptism of the Holy  
Spirit <sup>when</sup> he said in Acts 1:5 ...John Baptized with water. You shall  
be baptized with the Holy Spirit.

~~.....~~ Luke 3:16 <sup>Jesus</sup> ~~that~~ said that Jesus would baptize with the  
Holy Spirit and ~~.....~~ FIRE..... Why Fire?

Because you see, FIRE, in the Bible is a sign of the divine presence <sup>of God</sup>  
Our God is a consuming fire. The Holy Spirit is called the "SPIRIT OF BURING"  
In the O.T. when the Jews were in the wilderness a pillar of fire led <sup>them</sup> ~~these~~  
way at night. The fire was a sign of God's presence.

Moses saw the burning bush and God spoke to him from that bursh.  
There was the burning altar in the case of Isaiah and Elijah. All the way  
through the Bible FIRE represents God's presence.

So, the miracle they were seeing which was a sign to them ~~was~~ <sup>That</sup>....  
GOD IS IN THIS PLACE..... ~~.....~~ <sup>Spirit of</sup> ~~.....~~ <sup>The Sound and the Fire</sup>

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Now, what was the third miracle? ....And OH, how we have trouble here.  
What was the third miracle? It was the miracle of speaking.

Some say, "I think it is a miralce of hearing. No, it is a miracle of  
speaking. There is no question about that.

Acts 2:4...And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to  
speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance....."

Now, I would like to translate that last statement literally.....  
<sup>They</sup> ~~HE~~ BEGAN TO SPEAK IN LANGUAGES DIFFERENT FROM THEIR OWN.....

~~on~~ <sup>the</sup> word "other" means "another of a different kind".....THEY  
BEGAN TO SPEAK IN LANGUAGES DIFFERENT FROM THEIR OWN, <sup>languages</sup> AS THE SPRIT WAS GIVING  
TO THEM <sup>No ability to do so</sup> TO BE SPEAKING OUT.....

Now, why do I point this out?

omit

The phrase that says "the spirit gave"....or "was giving"...refers to  
a continuous operation.

The fact is that not one of these men was given a gift and all of a sudden he had it. And any time he could turn on.....That is not what the Bible teaches.

The Bible teaches that the Holy Spirit was continuously as long as they were speaking out, the Spirit of God was controlling them, continually....

No man ever spoke out this way in a language he did not know without the Holy Spirit continually speaking through him. The Holy Spirit was giving them this ability continually. Do You Understand

And what was the ability?....<sup>!</sup>To speak out....It is translated in Vs 14 as ~~"speaking out"~~ by the word declared: declared or said raised his voice and ~~said~~ ~~or~~ ~~said~~.....It means "TO SPEAK OUT".

There is a boldness behind this word that is used very little in the entire N.T. Two of which are found right here in Acts 2. To speak out boldly...Clearly.....These men had a miracle of speaking.

Over again, WHAT WAS THAT MIRACLE?.....It was to speak in different languages other than their own.

Now, will you turn back to the Gospel of Mark chapter 16.... The book of Mark chapter 16. We should not be surprised at these men at Pentecost speaking different languages because the Lord Jesus predicted it. Mark 16....Here is the GREAT COMMISSION of Jesus.....Vs 15..."Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

Vs 17...."And these signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new what?....TONGUES... which is the word for LANGUAGES.....

omit

Vs 20 ....And they went out and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked, with them, and confirmed the word by the signs that followed."

The spoken word was confirmed by miracleous signs. And one of those signs was to speak in new tongues or as the Greek says "NEW LANGUAGES".

Now, come back to Acts chapter 2, again, pleas.....

Three miracles.....You will notice that at the end of Vs 6, this statement: "THE MULTITUDE WAS BEWILDERED BECAUSE...THEY WERE EACH ONE HEARING THEM SPEAK IN HIS OWN LANGUAGE OR TONGUE OR DIALECT....

Now, notice this please. In Vs 6, it says "language" or "dialect". It is not the same word as the word in Vs 4, "tongue". The word in Vs 4 also appears in Vs 11.. "tongue". And the word "language" in Vs 6, also, appears in Vs 8. In both cases it is the word "dialect".

Now, why do I point this out? Because the word "dialect" and the word "tongue" are used syn.on'y.mously (synonymously).

And there is no question about the word "tongue" being "language". But, some people seem to think there is a difference. Some people seem to think that this is a static utterance. That is a heavenly language that is not discernable. That is pure nonsense. Because Vs 6 and Vs 8 clears that up when it uses the word "dialect". It is talking about dialects of nations, of people who are actually living on the earth.

SO, WHAT WAS THE MIRACEL OF <sup>speaking?</sup> PENTECOST?

These men were able, under the Holy Spirit contineious control, to speak in known languages which were different from their own. They were able to speak in different languages. The Holy Spirit gave them that ability. And people heard the message. And 3000 souls were saved .

Let me tell you...on the day of Pentecost...<sup>There three</sup> Miracles were taking place.

(2 ) Secondly, as to what happened on the day of Pentecost... First of all, miracles were taking place. And secondly, a new ministry of the Holy Spirit was begun. WHAT WAS THIS NEW MINISTRY?

According to Acts 1:5, it was the baptism of the Holy Spirit. The baptism of the Holy Spirit <sup>which caused</sup> ~~and~~ The Formation of The church. <sup>That's why we call the day</sup> ~~of Pentecost~~ The Birth day of The church

Now, what is the baptism of the Holy Spirit? The answer is found in I Cor. chapter 12. Would you turn there, please. I Cor. chapter 12..beginning with Vs 12.

What was the Baptism of the Holy Spirit? This is not baptism in water... even though baptism in water is a symbol of the Baptist of the Holy Spirit.

I Cor. chapter 12 verse 12...(READ Vs 12-13)

I Cor 12:13

WHAT IS THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT?.....It is the day and continuous operation of the Holy Spirit by which he puts every person who receives Christ into one body in Jesus Christ.....That one body...that one new man is the CHURCH...

Ephesian 1 says that the church is HIS BODY, THE FULLNESS OF HIM <sup>who</sup> ~~THEY~~  
FILLS ~~PERISH~~ ALL IN ALL.....

Colosians 1 says that Christ has been made the head over the church which is his body.

The church began on the day of Pentecost.....Jesus said in John 16 that unless he ascended to the Father the Holy Spirit would not come. And ten days after <sup>Jesus</sup> he ascended the Holy Spirit came. The church began on the day of Pentecost. And it includes all people who coming to accept Jesus Christ into their lives and in turn are baptized by the Holy Spirit into one body in Christ Jess. *called the church Pentecost is the Birthday of the church*

Now, what does that mean?...It means that the Holy Spirit literally comes into your life.

When does the Holy Spirit come into a person's life?....According to Romans chapter 8, the moment...the exact moment one receives Jesus Christ as Saviour.....At that moment the Holy Spirit comes into the believer...

You see, the one thing that makes everyone of us in one body in Christ if we are truly believers, is the presence of the Holy Spirit. It is not our likes or dislikes.

I know you are going to find this hard to believe. But, there are some things that you like that I don't.....Now, that is hard to believe.....

And the people seating right next to you. There are some things that they will do, but you will not.....[And thus, we begin to say: HOW CAN WE BE ONE?....IF WE ARE ALL BAPTIZED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT, HOW COME WE DON'T ACT AND THINK ALIKE?.....

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit that makes us one is the ~~presence~~ personal presence of the Holy Spirit in every believers life. That which makes us one is that both of us who have come to know Christ are indwelt by the Holy Spirit.....

One

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit began on the day of Pentecost. And this was a new ministry. The baptism of the Holy Spirit was never in the O.T

(2 ) The second thing that began on the day of Pentecost as a new ministry of the Spirit was the filling of the Holy Spirit.

In Acts 2:4 it says "they were all filled with the Holy Spirit.

Now, look at Vs 13.....When the multitude saw these people who were filled with the Holy Spirit what did they conclude?.....Vs 13...."They are full of sweet wine".... *They were drunk*

Peter said "well, unless we are really ~~craze~~, there is something wrong with your logic."

You say, "I didn't read that in my text."....No...that is my interpretati

Because Peter did say it was the third hour of the day. And in a Jewish day that would be 9:00 in the morning.....We are really alcoholics if we are drinking sweet wine at 9:00 in the morning.....

Peter said this isn't drunkenness. We are filled with the Holy Spirit. The point that I want you to see, here, is: the filling of the Spirit never began until Pentecost. Even though the Holy Spirit came on people and in a sense filled them temporary. But, God's Holy Spirit, now, can fill people continuously.....HOW DO I KNOW THAT?.....CAN A PERSON BE ASSURED THAT HE CAN BE CONTINUOUSLY FILLED?.....YES.....

Were people continuously filled before Pentecost?....Only on two occasions. One, John the Baptist. He was full of the Holy Spirit from when?.....From his mother's womb.....

And the second person, of course, was Jesus Christ. He was full of the Holy Spirit his entire life.

HOW DID THE HOLY SPIRIT OPERATE ON PEOPLE IN THE O.T.? He came on them and then left them. He inspired them for a certain function or responsibility or service, but did not remain with them constantly.

IS THERE ANY WHERE IN THE BIBLE THAT TEACHES THAT CHRISTIANS CAN BE CONSTANTLY UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE HOLY SPIRIT?.....YES.....

Turn to Ephesians chapter 5.....Ephesians chapter 5....begining at 17

(Read 5:17-18)



That is in a present tense....meaning: constant, continually, filling of the Holy Spirit.

And may I remind you that it is commanded....No where in the O.T. did God command men to be filled with the spirit. And yet He commands Christians to be filled with the Spirit.

You know, one of the greatest things a christian could ever realize, is that there are two kinds of Christians....This is one of the greatest things that could get awhole of you....And I am afraid that many of us hear it, but we never get awhole of it. We hear it, we listen to it, but it never gets awhole of us. There are two kinds of Christians. And there is not a spiritual ladder between the two. There are only two: CARNAL AND SPIRITUAL....

Carnal means to "operate in the flesh".....And "spiritual" means "to operate under the control of the spirit."

And a lot of us will set Sunday after Sunday some how believing that God has a ladder by which we progress into different areas of spirituality.

Just

And I say to you that Ephesians 5:18 is a command....Every time I read this I think: How could God say this if it were to be an up and down experience. Or if it were to apply to just a certain area of my life. Or just for a particular service... This is a command. And God commands every christian, you and me, everyone of us, to be constantly under the control of God's Holy Spirit. We are either under the control of Spirit or we are under the control of the flesh. You can be a Christian and operate just like an unbeliever. This is one of the sad things. Some folks come to me and say, "Well, so and so says they are a christian. But he doesn't even act as good as the fellow across the street who is not a Christian.".....Well, the reason is that even though we have come to know Christ and the Spirit dwelling within us, if we are not letting the Holy Spirit control us, we will appear as though we are an un-believer. We are carnal. We are living just like an unbeliever would.....

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The difference, thank God, is faith in Christ. And there is no condemnation to those who are in Christ. And I will be in heaven someday because I have ask Christ to come into my life. But, in acturally reality and practice there are two kinds of Christians: CARNAL AND SPIRITUAL. And the filling of the Holy Spirit and constant control began on the Day of Pentecost. And every christian from that point on is commanded by God to be constantly under the control of God's Holy Spirit.

The one common illustration which you have ~~is~~ Acts 2:13 and Eph 5:18, Also Luke 1:15 is DRUNKNESS WITH WINE.... *What Does it mean to be filled*

Just as a person who is drunk is under the control of that wine, that alcoholic beaverage, so, also, when you are controlled by the Holy Spirit you are under the control of the Spirit of God. And men of the world will sometimes conclude about Christians that must be drunk or out off their minds. Folks, can we not say that what is really wrong with us is that there are very few christians who are really under the entroll of the Holy Spirit. Many of us could go week after week, day after day, as we have always gone, and never feel sensitive at all to the control of the Holy Spirit.....Life as usually....The filling of the Spirit began at Pentecost.

(3) Comeing Back to Acts 2, the third thing that started at Pentedost was the power of the Spirit. Because of his filling, because of his baptism, the power of the spirit was available.

Acts 1:8 said "You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you.....POWER FOR WHAT?.....TO BE WITNESSES....."

You know, I think about this so much....And I am sure you do a lot of thinking about it.....Jesus Christ promised POWER to witness to people... And the power of the Holy Spirit was given to every christian. Every Christian can witness in the power of the Spirit of God.

Baptized by the Spirit.....Yes...The moment you trust Christ you are put into one body...

Filled with the Holy Spirit... *Yes, once and for all time* God command that you be under the control of the Holy Spirit. If the world says you are drunk or look like you are drunk, then Praise the Lord, you are a fool for Christ's sake.

(4)

And the fourth thing that started on the day of Pentecost <sup>was</sup> ~~where~~ the gifts of the Spirit . The gifts of the sprit. How do I know that?

Chapter 2:4 says that the spirit of God was giving to these men the ability to speak out in these lanuages. And according to I Corin#thians chapter 12, the Holy Spirit has given gifts to his church. Not every one can speak out in new languages, WHY?.....

Because this was part of four miracleous gifts. In Romans chapter 12, in I Corinthains chapter 12, and Ephesiand chapter 4, we learn that there are gifts that the Holy Spirit has given to every christiann#. There are a total of 15 gifts. That is all there are. 15 gifts.....Four of those are what we would call miracleious: the ability to heal....the ability to speak in new languages.....the ability to interpret those languages...and fourth... the ability to work special miracles.....FOUR MIRACELOUS GIFTS....

And Accroding to Mark 16 and Hebrews chapter 2 they were given to the Apostle to confirm the spoken Word.....

Do we have those miracleious gifts today? Absolutely not....I don't believe you can prove it from the Bible.....

But, we have 11 others that <sup>are</sup> ~~are~~ in operation. And the Holy Spirit gives to every person as he wills. As the Spirit of God wants to....Every christiar has a spiritual gifts....

Now, will you look down at Vs <sup>1</sup> ~~2~~ Acts 2:7....and I want to tie this together.

(3)

The third <sup>They</sup> ~~point~~ as to what happened on the day of Bntecost is that the multitudes were amazed. I don't have the time to develop that todaight. But there ama<sup>2</sup>ement really centered in one thing. That Gallilean men who were not gifted speakers could speak in all those gifferent languages and dialects. They were absolutely ama<sup>2</sup>ed. They couldn't believe it. And they wandered what the meaning of all of this was.....

(4)

<sup>OK</sup> Well, the <sup>Third</sup> ~~fourth~~ thing that happened on the day of Pentecost was that the message of God's Word was being fullfilled. Notice beginning at Vs 14 Peter stands up to expaian the <sup>New</sup> ~~meaning~~ <sup>of Pentecost</sup>.....

Now, what is the point?.....The message of God was being fulfilled in <sup>Three</sup> ~~four~~ areas. Let me give them to you quickly....

1. <sup>The message of God</sup> ~~It~~ was being fulfilled at the start of what he called "LAST DAYS.

Last days.....The Bible teaches that there would be LAST DAYS. When did they begin? According to Peter they began on the day of Pentecost. Vs 17.... "And it shall be in the last days".....

When will those "last days" conclude?....They will conclude after the 70th week of Daniel, or, the 7 year period known as the Tribulation Period. It will be the end of those 'last days' that will usher in a new day..THE KINGDOM OF CHRIST ON EARTH: PEACE, RIGHTEOUSNESS, CHRIST RULING ON THE THRONE OF DAVID IN THE CITY OF JERSUELEM. *We live in the Last Days*

2. <sup>Secondly</sup> according to Peter in Vs 17 and 18 the message of God was being fulfilled as to the intention of Joel's prophecy about the Spirit.

Notice in Vs 17, "I will pour out my Spirit." In other words, what happened at Pentecost was foretold by <sup>The Prophet</sup> Joel. ~~The Holy Spirit would be upon whom?....~~ <sup>Quote Vs 17-1</sup> The Holy Spirit would be upon whom?.... If you will compare Joel with Acts 2 you will discover it is upon Jews....So, the people today who are trying to ~~recreate~~ reinact the experience of Pentecost are not following carefully what the Scripture says. It is upon Jews. And I remind you that according to the book of Revelation, there is going to be 144 thousand Jews in that great future period called "THE TRIBULATION PERIOD" who will speak ~~to~~ every nation, tongue and people. And bring the gospel of the kingdom to them. In other words, Jewish people in the complete fulfillment of Joel's prophecy, 144 thousand Jews in that period will be able to speak in all the languages of the world.

You know, if people had this gift today, I want to tell you, that it would save a lot of time in missionary work....We could send missionaries to fields <sup>missionaries who had this gift</sup> that had this gift. As God will some day do through the 144 thousand Jews. But, we could send them now, with the ability to talk in any other language without ever having studied it.....

*From that day until now the Gospel has been preached by men and women under the power of God's H.S*

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3. Then I notice, also, that the message of God is being fulfilled when you notice the intervention of God into human affairs.

According to Vs 19 and 20 there will be great wonders in the heavens and signs on the earth. Blood and fire and vapor of smoke. The sun turned to darkness and the moon into blood before what?...Before the great and glorious day of the Lord shall come.

My friends, Jesus Christ is coming back to this earth. The Bible teaches that wonderful principle. God almighty is going to super natural interven in human affairs. All things will not continue as they are now. Jesus Christ is coming back. And He will super naturally interven and miraculous signs will appear. Such as was foretold by the Prophet Joel and mentioned, here, by Peter.

Dear Friends, I pray that you all believe that. Because if you fail to believe that Jesus Christ is coming back, again, I say to you in all the love I can, that you are not a Christian. No matter how Christian you maybe in your actions and your ways and doings. You are not really a Christian, if you do not believe that Jesus Christ is coming back to planet earth. For there is no hope in what you then do believe. For the Apostle Paul said that we are saved by "THE HOPE". Our hope is resting upon the return of Jesus Christ.

Right now in your own hearts, if you believe that Jesus died on the cross for your sins, that He rose from the dead, that He appeared for 40 days and was seen by hundreds of people, that He ascended into heaven and He is going to come in like manner, if you believe that, according to the Bible, you will be saved...

Vs 21 clearly teaches that the message of God was being fulfilled when the universal proclamation of the gospel was made. Vs 21 says, "that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

That is why all of our hymns and chorus, today, centered around the name of Jesus. For there is no other name under heaven by which we must be saved. You shall call his name Jesus, for He shall save His people from their sins.  
Praise God

SOFTLY

And right now in the quietness of your own heart, if you would call upon the name of Jesus you too shall be saved. Trusting him for your salvation, believing in your heart that God raised him from the dead, and that He is coming back. The Bible says you shall be saved.

May God help you to understand. May God help you make that decision to accept him this very moment *as your personal Lord and savior*
